

## 5 Things to think about as you buy curriculum to work on Reading Comprehension

1. Vocabulary words- Does it offer vocabulary words? Are they broken down by chapter or section?
2. Detailed questions or Generic Questions- How much detail do you want? Do you want fill in the blank or complete sentences?
3. Review questions- Do you want the book to ask review questions for previous material? Do you want materials only covering the current chapter?
4. Do you want materials that ask questions chronologically in the chapter or in no particular order?
5. Do you want kids to write in their text or not? If not, how do you want them to take note of their materials?

1. Read the questions.
2. Look over the reading and look for bolded words and section titles.
3. As you read highlight or underline important details.
4. Go through and answer the questions looking back at what you read.

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
