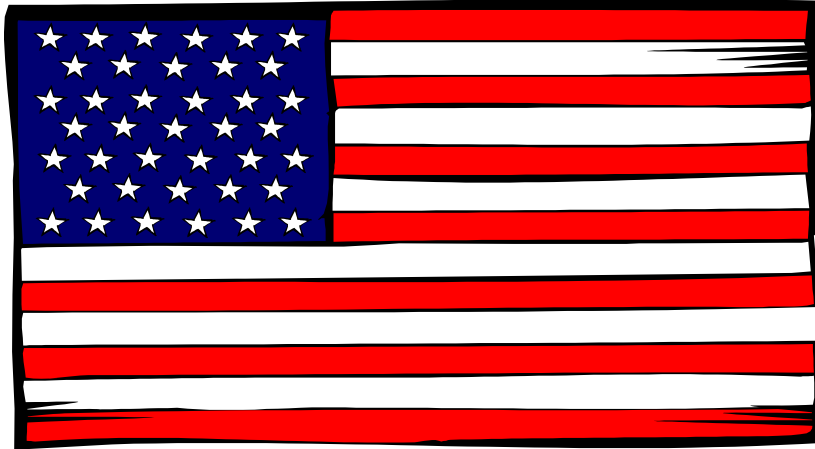


United States
